How to prepare your samples:

Wear gloves at all times! Recite selling points as consumers approach demo table.

Mountain High Yoghurt:

Step 1: Place Yoghurt in a cooler with ice to keep cold during your event.

Step 2: Fill soufflé cup 1/4th full with yogurt that is being sampled.

Step 3: Using a plastic spoon, serve one spoon full of granola over yoghurt in the soufflé cup.

Step 4: Ask consumers if they would like to try a sample. Serve yoghurt topped with granola to consumers with spoons while reciting selling points.

* Discard any samples left out longer than 10 minutes.

* Encourage consumers to take a coupon and purchase some today!

Post Event:

•Return product from table display to the shelf.

•DO NOT take sample product out of the store. Leave any leftover samples with the Store Manager or in the employee break room.

•Clean up, breakdown your table and leave your area as you found it.

•Complete your PromoReports® Form and obtain a store stamp and a manager's signature.

•Destroy any remaining coupons at the end of the day.

•It is mandatory that you enter your results online or call into PromoReports® to report your results upon demo completion. Product Safety Information

Subject: Specific Safety Information for the Mountain High Yoghurt and Nature Valley Granola products you are sampling today.

With the products you are sampling today for General Mills, we have taken great care to identify for the consumer the allergen information on the package that they need to protect themselves. We have also furnished you with a card which tells the consumers that the product contains allergens. PLEASE PLACE THE ALLERGEN PLACARD IN A VISIBLE PLACE FOR THE CONSUMER TO OBSERVE. But this doesn't protect any youth or children that could obtain a sample from you. It is important that you DO NOT GIVE OUT A SAMPLE TO YOUTH OR CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 13. This age is used to assure that the consuming youth understands their allergy and will avoid a material which they are allergic. You will also need to be careful that youth or young children under this age DO NOT JUST TAKE A SAMPLE without your awareness to question their age. It is OK if a parent chooses to give the food sample to a child under the age of 13.

It is estimated that approximately 2 percent of adults and about 5 percent of infants and young children in the United States suffer from food allergies. Each year, roughly 30,000 individuals require emergency room treatment and 150 individuals die because of allergic reactions to food.

Eight major foods or food groups—milk, eggs, fish, Crustacean (shellfish), tree nuts, peanuts, wheat, and soybeans—account for 90 percent of food allergies. At present, there is no cure for food allergies. A food allergic consumer must avoid the food to which the consumer is allergic.

A recent study shows that many parents of children with a food allergy were unable to correctly identify in each of several food labels the ingredients derived from major food allergens. Ingredients in foods must be listed by their "common or usual name". In some cases, the common or usual name of an ingredient may be unfamiliar to consumers, and many consumers may not realize the ingredient is derived from, or contains, a major food allergen. In other cases, the ingredients may be declared as a class, including spices, flavorings, and certain colorings, or are exempt from the ingredient labeling requirements, such as incidental additives.

We hope this information helps you understand allergens and helps protect the samplers.
